Change to the designation

Pov of student and parents regarding a dean position on campus

- Student has no opinion regarding the dean position, but he stated that an Intervention Coordinator sounds like it could be helpful.
- Parent-members state that a Dean or Intervention Prevention Support Coordinator is necessary for our campus in order to instill respect for the teachers and for our campus. After hearing our discussion, the parents reiterate this recommdation. As parents, they state that they hear about student activities on this campus that are unsafe. They would like to see the students receive consequences and be held accountable for their actions.
- Mr. Werthwein states that a dean would have to take an approach that is non-punitive and focuses on social-emotional in order to best support our students
- Dr. Kurban related that in her experiences, a restorative justice approach is best. She also reminded us that the dean comes off the norm
- Dr. Wolf and Mr. Deligencia explained how the funding would work for a Dean position. A dean is norm-funded, and would mean that it comes out of a pre-existing teacher position, which would increase class sizes for the designated teacher's department.
- An Intervention Coordinator position is an alternative solution, and this position would be budget-based
